Weekly Prayer Guide

Monday - Today, consider your sins against God. Is there any relationship that you have that is more important than spending time with God? Does God get what is left over after we get what we want? Do you ask God first on decisions that need to be made, or go to others first for their input? Remember, God loves you and wants to be first in your life.

Tuesday - Today, consider your sins against your neighbors. Do you want what is best for them at all times? Even if it is inconvenient, do you go out of your way to help them? Do you put their needs ahead of your own? To love your neighbor is to show your love to God.

Wednesday - Today, consider your sins against the world. It is our responsibility to take care of God's creation, to use it, and to enjoy it. Are you part of the problem of pollution, or are you working for solutions to clean up our environment? Do you take time to enjoy God's gifts to us? Praise God for His creation.

Thursday - Today, consider your sins against humanity. Do you see people through the eyes of God? Do you see people as being made in God's image and in need of salvation and redemption? Does it break your heart to see millions of innocent babies being killed for the sake of "convenience"? Have you become numb to the violence on our streets and lack of civility in our society? "The only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is for good men to do nothing." (attributed to Edmund Burke)

Friday - Pray for Pastor Mark and Pastor Zac as they shepherd our congregation. Pray for their physical, spiritual, and moral protection, as well as for their families. Ask God to put a hedge of protection around them as they serve Him.

Saturday - Pray for families, which are the backbone of society. Families are being challenged on so many fronts: disrespect of authority, divorce, alcohol, drugs, internet, lack of moral footing, violence, and other moral issues. Pray for a revival in families, that they may realize that God is the answer to all their problems and questions about living an abundant life.

Sunday - May we come before God today with clean hearts and an open spirit to worship Him. May God be honored and glorified today and His people be blessed.
